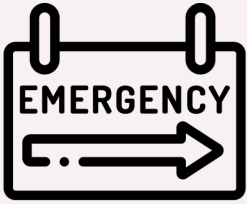

1 EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In case of an accident or medical emergency, contact 911.



2 INCIDENT REPORTING

To report damage or accidents on park land, contact the Rock Creek Park Permit Specialist at 202-895-6013.

To report suspicious or dangerous activity on park land, call the Park Police at 202-610-7500.

After contacting emergency responders, report incident to the Garden Manager at 202-746-2339.



3 IN CASE OF CUTS OR ABRASIONS

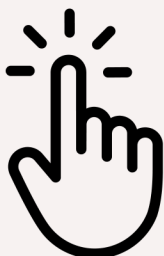
For minor cuts, use the First Aid Kit located in the shed.

For major cuts, tightly wrap wound in a clean cloth and seek immediate emergency medical attention.



4 PROTECTION FROM SUN, WIND, AND RAIN

- Wear a hat, long sleeves, and long pants
- Avoid working in the hottest part of the day
- Make use of available shade
- Take regular breaks
- Have sunscreen available and reapply as required
- Have adequate drinking water available



5 BITES, STINGS, AND POISONOUS PLANTS

- Remain vigilant and aware of surroundings
- If unsure about particular plants, leave alone and check with a garden leader or another garden member
- Apply insect repellent
- Check for ticks regularly
- If you think it is poison ivy, it probably is. Wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants and gloves when removing poison ivy
- In case of snake bite, seek immediate medical attention
